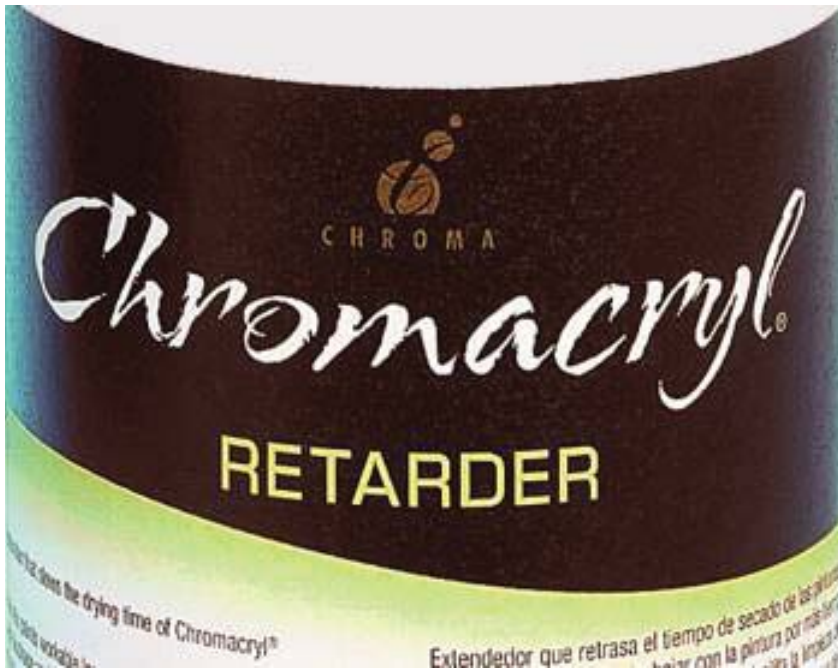


## Using Chromacryl® Retarder Medium



### Product Description:

An extender that slows the drying time of Chromacryl acrylic paints. Also use for silk-screen printing.



**Note:** For making an edition of prints - the *printing paper*, *stencil* and *screen* will need to be registered by making marks to show where to place the items each time a print is made, so that each one is exactly the same.

**1.** Make stencil by drawing shapes onto paper and cutting out where the paint is to print through to form image..





**2.** Place stencil onto printing paper surface.



**3.** Place screen over stencil.



4. Mix the Retarder Medium into the paint thoroughly.



5. Place an amount of paint at the top of the screen.





6. Firmly and evenly pull the paint with a squeegee through the screen at a 45° angle. Print the quantity of prints required.



7. When printing is completed, remove the stencil from the screen.



8. (The print and the original stencil).



9. Wash the screen mesh thoroughly in warm soapy water. The Retarder Medium not only reduces screen blockage when printing but makes cleaning easier.
