# Crafting Instructions

## Supplies Needed:

1 roll of Blue and Chrome Duck Tape®  
Optional materials: cutting board, work surface, scissors or cutting tool.



1. Tear a strip of Blue Duck Tape that is about 6 inches long (1-2 inches longer than your electronic device), and place it on your flat surface sticky side down.



2. Tear 3-4 strips to the same size and place next to each other, overlapping the edges just slightly to create a "sheet" of Duck Tape.



3. Carefully pull the "sheet" up and turn over, sticky side up. Cover this side with overlapping strips going in the opposite direction.



4. Once the sticky side of the sheet is covered, trim off any excess tape to make a rectangle.



5. Fold the sheet in half to create the body of the case, and then tape the two sides with small pieces of Chrome Duck Tape® to seal the edges. Trim any excess.



6. Use the Chrome Duck Tape to decorate the case with any design you can think of!!



## Tips and Ideas:

- ★ Design a monogrammed case by creating your initials out of Chrome Duck Tape®.
- ★ Make a tab over the case opening to help keep contents inside.
- ★ For a crisscross or plaid pattern, use even skinnier strips of Duck Tape by tearing the tape in half.
- ★ Create "appliqués" by making small "sheets" of Duck Tape (Steps 1-4). Use scissors to cut out desired shapes and adhere with Duck Tape. (Polka Dots, Hearts, Stars, Train, Sports Theme, School Letters, Musical Notes, etc).
