ROSES CRAFT

Once you get started, your imagination is your only limit!



Crafting Instructions

Supplies Needed:

1 roll of Red, Pink and Green Duck Tape®, 6 straws
Optional materials: cutting board, work surface, scissors or cutting tool.



To create the stem:

1. Tear a piece of Green Duck Tape slightly longer than the length of a straw. Wrap the straw with a piece of Green Duck Tape.



To make a rose petal:

2. Tear a piece of Red Duck Tape about 2 inches long. With the sticky side up, fold one corner of the piece toward the middle, leaving some adhesive exposed.



3. Repeat Step 2 with the other corner so a petal point is created. Make sure plenty of adhesive is exposed on the bottom. Lay petal onto flat surface.

4. Repeat Steps 2 and 3 about 15 more times to create all the petals for 1 rose. Lay the petals on your flat surface, so they're easy to grab when you begin building a rose.

5. Cover one end of the straw /stem with a small piece of Red Duck Tape®.



6. Loosely wrap each petal around the top of the straw. Adhere each petal a bit further away from the center of the rose to make it appear in full bloom.



7. Finish the rose by wrapping a small piece of Red Duck Tape around the base of the flower to hide any wrinkles or uneven edges.



To create a small leaf:

8. Repeat Steps 2 and 3 with Green Duck Tape and adhere to the rose stem.

9. Repeat entire process with Pink Duck Tape to create a half dozen bouquet of Duck Tape Roses!



Tips and Ideas:

- ★ Instead of sticking the petals flat around the stem, "pucker" them for a realistic look.
- ★ Spray your favorite fragrance on the roses for a personalized touch.
- ★ Create longer leaves by folding the Green Duck Tape in half and cutting long "leaf" shapes with scissors. Adhere to the stem with Duck Tape.
- ★ Alternate petals of Red and Pink Duck Tape to create a hybrid rose.
- ★ Store your roses in a personalized vase by covering an empty and clean soup can with the remaining Duck Tape.
